Prerequisites

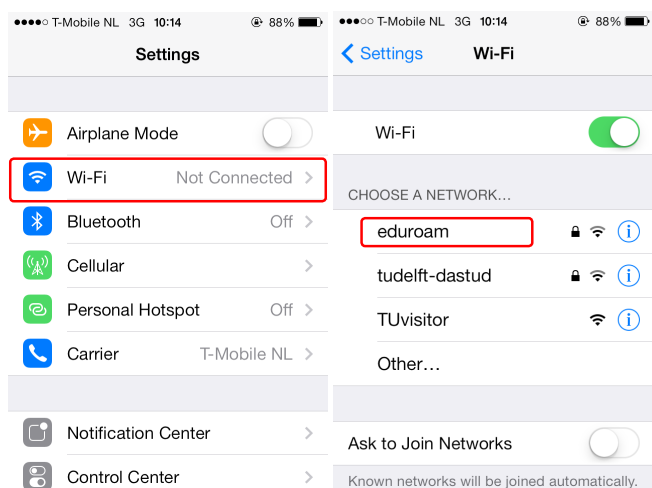
This manual **ONLY** applies to iOS version 7.0.0 and further. You can check the system version in the "General Settings" menu under "About".

Also make sure your NetID is activated and that your NetID account hasn't been locked out.

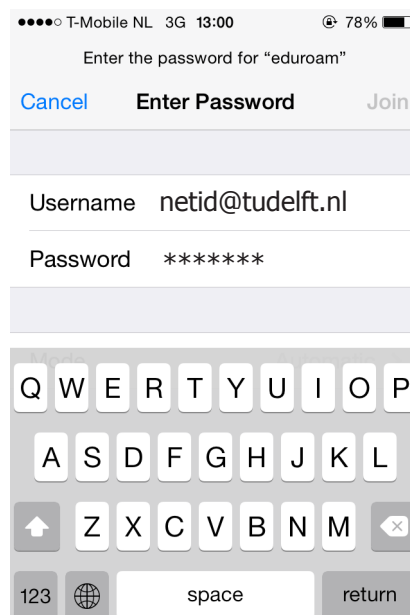
Connecting your iPhone or iPad to eduroam

Step 1. Open the Wi-Fi menu in the settings, Make sure your Wi-Fi is switched on,

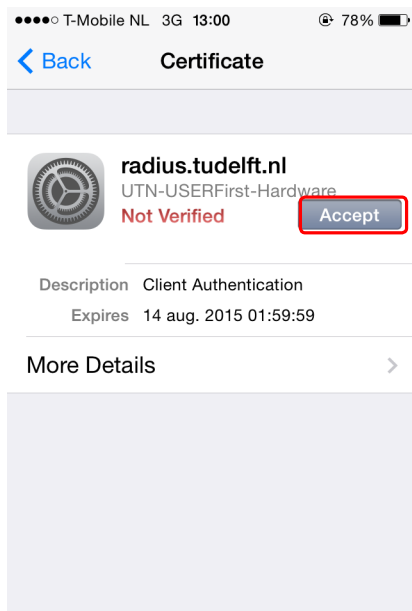
Tap the **Eduroam** Network.



Step 2. Type in your **netid with @tudelft.nl** and your **password**.



Step 3. Tap **Accept**.



Step 4. You will now be connected.
