### Free Electives on Digital Design and Asset Management for all CE/ODE/CME/TIL MSc students

In Q1 and Q2 three elective MSc courses are offered in the area of Digital Design and Asset Management. These courses are open for all MSc-students CE, ODE, CME and TIL and are complementary to the different engineering domains.

The following courses are offered in Q1:

CIE 4381 Engineering Asset Management, by prof. Rogier Wolfert, dr. Daan Schraven, ir. Martine vd Boomen.

This course provides an overview of engineering asset management principles and techniques: e.g. performance requirement contracting system life cycle processes, (probabilistic) costing & scheduling, operations and maintenance management, risk management planning and engineering asset optimisation and financing.

Lecture day is Wednesdays 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> hour.

First lecture: Wednesday 5 September, 15.45-17.30h.

CIE 4120 Information Systems for Construction, by dr. Sander van Nederveen, prof. Rogier Wolfert and guest lecturers

This course provides an introduction into information management and into digital methods and tools for different engineering asset phases such as Design/Construct/Operate/Maintain. Three tools will have a dominant role in this course: BIM/Revit&Navisworks; SE/Relatics; O&M management/Maximo.

Lecture days are Monday 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> hour and practical work on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> hour in Q1.

First lecture: Monday 10 September, 13.45-15.30h.

The following course is offered in Q2:

CIE 4481 Systems Engineering Management, by dr. Sander van Nederveen and prof. Rogier Wolfert.

In this course an overview of concepts, principles and practices of system analysis, design and development is given. Systems Engineering (SE) will be applied from different perspectives over the entire life cycle of civil engineering assets

Lecture day is: Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> hour.

First lecture: Thursday 15 November, 15.45-17.30h.

These courses can be chosen as separate electives. However, these courses are as bundle also part of the Integral Design & Management (IDM) annotation, see [www.tudelft.nl/citg/IDMannotation](http://www.tudelft.nl/citg/IDMannotation)
