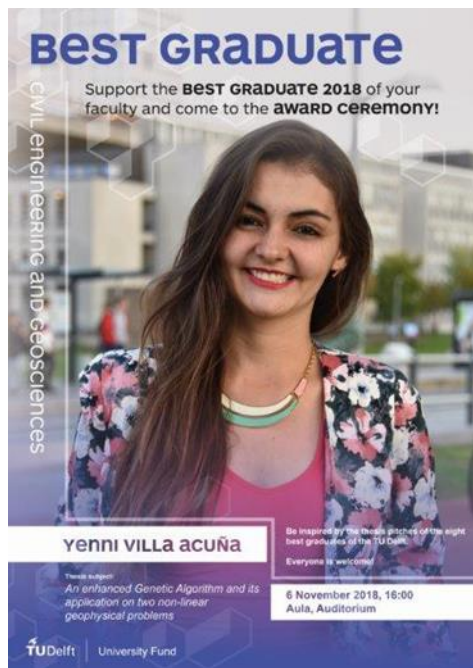

Best Graduate TU Delft Ceremony 6 November

Best Graduate CEG: Yenni Paloma Villa Acuña



We are happy to announce that ir. Yenni Paloma Villa Acuña has been nominated to represent our faculty during the 'Best of TU Delft' Award Ceremony on November 6th. Yenni completed her master's degree in Applied Earth Sciences. Her thesis work is part of the IDEA-League Master Program and is done as an internship at Aramco Overseas Company BV in Delft. Minimisation and optimisation are at the heart of many challenges oil & gas companies face in structural imaging of the subsurface in oil & gas exploration. Many algorithms and ideas struggle to find robust solutions because of the scale and complexity of the subsurface.

During a period of 5 months, Yenni created new ideas to make a general optimisation method significantly faster and more robust. She also demonstrated the applicability of the new method to a number of synthetic data sets that are well-known in the field of numerical optimization, as well as to seismic data processing algorithms that are used by many oil & gas companies.

The quality of the results achieved are extraordinary. Yenni's thesis was rewarded with an impressive 9.5 and her work has already been recognized as state of the art in current seismic processing software.

"Yenni worked very independently on her thesis while taking the suggestions of her supervisors seriously. She managed to defend her thesis as good as perfectly. Besides her thesis work, she also did her course work very well, with excellent marks in all 3 high-standard European universities (ETH, TUD and RWTH)."

MSc Elective Course CIE 4481 Systems Engineering and Management in Q2

In Q2, course CIE 4481 Systems Engineering and Management will be offered. In this course an overview of concepts, principles and practices of system analysis, design and development is given and this is applied to the civil infrastructure domain.

The aim of this elective is to educate students in system-based design and engineering methods, as a complement to the technical knowledge and skills developed in other courses.

Lectures are every Thursday 7th and 8th hour, attendance is mandatory. Next to that, assistance meetings can be planned on demand. Lecturers are dr ir Sander van Nederveen, dr ir Ruud Binnekamp and prof dr ir Rogier Wolfert. Please enroll on Brightspace if you want to join this course.

This course is one of the compulsory courses of the IDM annotation, but can also be followed as a separate elective. This course is the successor of former course CIE 4480. CME students can use this course as part of course CME 1210, as explained in the interim regulation on CME 1210. More info on this course or the IDM annotation can be obtained from the lecturers.
