
## Study Abroad – Safe Travel Training Session 18 December

**Aanmeldingsprocedure, interne selectieprocedure TU Delft en deadlines**

Je kunt je zelf aanmelden voor deze programma's tot 31-01-2018 via de reguliere procedure van Tokyo Institute of Technology ([zie website](#)).

Daarnaast mail je een print van je aanmelding inclusief de vereiste bijlagen (o.a. een gewaarmerkte cijferlijst) plus, als extra documenten, een motiveringsbrief en een curriculum vitae naar het Education Service Centre (email: [contactcentre-esa@tudelft.nl](mailto:contactcentre-esa@tudelft.nl)) voor **22-01-2019**.

De Mobility groep van het Education Service Centre selecteert uit alle aanmeldingen voor het course-oriented program één kandidaat, die voor 31-01-2019 wordt genomineerd bij Tokyo Institute of Technology.

De selectie vindt plaats op basis van het GPA. Bij meerdere kandidaten van één faculteit met hetzelfde GPA vragen we aan het facultaire International Office om een nominatie volgorde aan te geven.

Tokyo Tech hanteert geen quotas voor het research-oriented program. Ze kunnen maximaal 25 studenten accepteren voor beide programma's gezamenlijk.

**Selectieprocedure Tokyo Institute of Technology en uitslag**

De selectieprocedure is competitief waarbij Tokyo Tech voor wat betreft het course oriented program prioriteit geeft aan de door de TU genomineerde kandidaat. Naar verwachting worden omstreeks 28 februari 2019 de kandidaten geïnformeerd over de uitslag.
