Architectural Design Crossovers MSc 2 studio considers experimenting as a central axis of architectural design investigation with a multidisciplinary and intescalar approach. Sharing the same etymological origin with “experience” and “expert”, the term “experiment” defines the investigative yet formative characteristics of architectural design process. Therefore, the studio seeks to engage in a process-based design inquiry that starts with, or leads to site-specific interventions across spatial and temporal scales.

Within this framework, the students will use sythetic analysis to probe site conditions where different modes of representation can be employed as speculative design instruments forming architectural constructs that probes the scope of architectural project and the disciplinary boundaries.

Due to the nature of the studio, international collaboration, workshops and participation at architectural events are integral to the coursework. The MSc 2 studio will provide a central theme to be renewed every year.

A relatively long educational excursion (7–14 days) with on-site workshops is part of the studio program. The corresponding information is to be communicated at the first meeting of the semester.
